Pool Rental Details, please read:

- o Rentals get exclusive use of the pool for 1 hour & 30 minutes at the designated time above. *Pool party rentals are limited to 50 guests.*
- o Rentals also get exclusive use of the pool party room for 2 hours. *Pool party room accommodates 24-30 persons comfortably.*
 - o Renters can set-up 30 minutes prior to rental and will have 30 minutes after for clean-up.
 - o Renters can bring in food/snacks, drinks, etc. All food and beverages must stay in the party room.
 - o Party room includes: direct access to the pool, 4, 6-ft tables with 3-4 chairs on each side, countertop space, sink, and trash.
- o **CHILDREN UNDER SIX (6) YEARS OF AGE MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN INDIVIDUAL EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, THE ADULT WILL REMAIN WITH THE CHILD AT ALL TIMES AND THEY SHOULD BOTH BE DRESSED TO SWIM.**
- o GLASS OF ANY KIND IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA. This includes but is not limited to: goggles, bottles, containers, toys, mirrors, etc.
- o Guests can bring in floats, toys, etc. and must provide own towels.
- o Please be advised the height restriction for the slide is 48" mandated by the manufacturer. If children do not meet the height requirement they will not be allowed to utilize the slide, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- o Lifeguards provided.

CEDAR VALLEY SPORTSLEX POOL RULES

General Pool Area

- Children under six (6) years of age must be accompanied by an individual eighteen (18) years of age or older, the adult will remain with the child at all times and they should both be dressed to swim.
- Use of pool may be denied if an individual is apparently unable to care for him/herself, under the influence of alcohol or drugs, has open sores, wounds, evidence of a contagious disease, inappropriate swimwear, including cut-offs or any condition that would jeopardize the health and safety of the general public.
- No running, jumping, scuffling or rough play anywhere.
- Abusive or profane language is prohibited.
- Showers must be taken before entering the pool area.
- Non-swimmers will not be permitted in water deeper than their chest
- Swimmers must stay off lifeguard stands. No exceptions.
- Inner tubes, balls, flotation devices, swim fins, and mermaid tails are not permitted.
- Hanging on the life ropes is not permitted.
- No glass allowed in the pool area. This includes but is not limited to: goggles, bottles, containers, toys, mirrors, exercise equipment, etc.
- Abuse of the property will not be permitted.
- No pets allowed in the pool area.
- No smoking is allowed in the pool area or building.
- A patron may be ejected from the pool after consulting the Manager and filling out an incident report which will be copied and given to the Leisure Services Manager.
- No public displays of affection are allowed in the pool area.
- Gum, food or drinks are not allowed in the pool.
- The Leisure Services Commission is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Running is not permitted.
- Valuable items must be turned over the Manager.
- No street shoes or clothes in the pool.
- Children not toilet trained must wear a special aquatic swim diaper in the pool.
- NO DIVING IN POOL.

Waterslide Rules

- All riders must be at least 48" tall.
- Maximum rider weight is 300 pounds.
- Only one rider at a time – no chains or trains of riders. Warning: Water depth is shallow. Staff will instruct the next rider when it is clear to begin their ride.
- Non-Swimmers are not permitted.
- Riders must enter the slide in a seated position and wait for the instructions from the lifeguard stationed at the slide starter tub.
- All riders must ride feet first while lying on their back with arms crossed across their chest.
- Propelling oneself into the ride is prohibited.
- No running, standing, kneeling, rotating, tumbling, or stopping in the flume. Arms and hands must remain inside the flume at all times. Riders should remain in proper riding position until forward movement is terminated. At no time should the rider attempt to stand up while on the slide or prior to coming to a complete stop in the splash out area.
- Exit the catch pool immediately. Individuals must exit the catch pool area before the next rider can be sent.
- Riders must be in good health. Elderly persons, those suffering from heart disease, high blood pressure, epilepsy, or persons using prescription medication should consult their physician before using the slide. Individuals with medical conditions including, but not limited to pregnancy, heart or back problems should not ride.
- Do not use the slide while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Rider assumes all risk of injury due to misuse of this slide or failure to follow these rules.
- Parents/guardians of children under the age of 16 are strongly encouraged to observe the activity prior to deciding whether to allow their child to participate.
