

LEISURE POOL RULES

General Pool Area

- Children five (5) years of age and younger must be accompanied by an individual sixteen (16) years of age
 or older, the adult must remain with the child, and they should both be dressed to swim.
- Children nine (9) years of age and younger must be actively supervised by an adult.
- Use of pool may be denied if an individual is apparently unable to care for him/herself, under the
 influence of alcohol or drugs, has open sores, wounds, evidence of a contagious disease, inappropriate
 swimwear, including cut-offs or any condition that would jeopardize the health and safety of the general
 public.
- No running, jumping, scuffling or rough play anywhere.
- Abusive or profane language is prohibited.
- Showers must be taken before entering the pool area.
- Non-swimmers will not be permitted in water deeper than their chest. Children wearing life vests will be treated as a non-swimmer and must have an adult present in the water at all times.
- Swimmers must stay off lifeguard stands. No exceptions.
- Inner tubes, balls, flotation devices, swim fins, and mermaid tails are not permitted unless having approved at the managers discretion.
- Hanging on the life ropes is not permitted.
- No glass allowed in the pool area. This includes but is not limited to: goggles, bottles, containers, toys, mirrors, exercise equipment, etc.
- Abuse of the property will not be permitted.
- No pets allowed in the pool area.
- No smoking is allowed in the pool area or building.
- A patron may be ejected from the pool after consulting the Manager and filling out an incident report which will be copied and given to the Leisure Services Manager.
- No public displays of affection are allowed in the pool area.
- Gum, food or drinks are not allowed in the pool.
- The Leisure Services Commission is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Running is not permitted.
- Valuable items must be turned over the Manager.
- No street shoes or clothes in the pool.
- Children not toilet trained must wear a special aquatic swim diaper in the pool.
- NO DIVING IN POOL.

Waterslide Rules

- All riders must be at least 48" tall.
- Maximum rider weight is 300 pounds.
- Only one rider at a time no chains or trains of riders.
- Warning: Water depth is shallow. Staff will instruct the next rider when it is clear to begin their ride.
- Non-Swimmers are not permitted.
- Riders must enter the slide in a seated position and wait for the instructions from the lifeguard stationed at the slide starter tub.
- All riders must ride feet first while lying on their back with arms crossed across their chest.
- Propelling oneself into the ride is prohibited.

- No running, standing, kneeling, rotating, tumbling, or stopping in the flume. Arms and hands must remain inside the flume at all times. Riders should remain in proper riding position until forward movement is terminated. At no time should the rider attempt to stand up while on the slide or prior to coming to a complete stop in the splash out area.
- Exit the catch pool immediately. Individuals must exit the catch pool area before the next rider can be sent.
- Riders must be in good health. Elderly persons, those suffering from heart disease, high blood pressure, epilepsy, or persons using prescription medication should consult their physician before using the slide.
 Individuals with medical conditions including, but not limited to pregnancy, heart or back problems should not ride.
- Do not use the slide while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Rider assumes all risk of injury due to misuse of this slide or failure to follow these rules.
- Parents/guardians of children under the age of 16 are strongly encouraged to observe the activity prior to deciding whether to allow their child to participate.

Current Channel Rules

- Patrons are not permitted to stand, sit or crawl on island in middle of channel.
- Patrons shall take caution when jumping into current channel.
- No rough play or scuffling is permitted.

Basketball Hoop

- Hanging on the rim or net is not permitted.
- Patrons must be in the water when shooting. No long distance shooting is permitted.
- Patrons are not allowed to jump into the water while shooting the basketball.
- Basketballs will be removed from patrons if need be.

Pool Rentals

- All of rules stated above are to be enforced during pool rentals.
- No food, drink or gum is allowed on pool deck at any time during a pool rental.
- Doors leading to party rooms are to remain closed at all times. Propping doors open may result in ventilation failure.
- Pool rental hosts are responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of the pool area.
- Guests are responsible for any damage to the pool and facility.
- Alcoholic beverages, smoking and use of other drugs are not permitted in pool area and building.
